SD POETIC BREW REVIVAL FEATURING LOCAL LEGENDS

San Diego's *Poetic Brew*, previously hosted at the Claire de Lune coffee lounge in North Park and known to feature open readings from the best poetic talents locally and across the country, is on a revival mission. Local poet legends, **Michael Klam** and **Ted Washington**, have teamed up as featured poets for the re-opening night, Tuesday, September 18, 2007 at 8 p.m. behind it's new doors of **Rebecca's**, a coffee house located at 3015 Juniper Street in South Park, San Diego, with an open mic to follow.

Both **Klam** and **Washington** are published authors of several poetry collections. **Klam** is a regular contributor to San Diego CityBeat, San Diego Source: The Daily Transcript, and La Prensa San Diego. He has organized the Poetry & Art series in the Museum of the Living Artist since 2001. **Washington** is a celebrated poet, artist and performance artist. He has lived in the San Diego area for over 20 years and has been publishing art and poetry for over 10. His unique performance style and original art have won him featured poet and artist invitations throughout Southern California.

Poetic Brew is set to be scheduled every third Tuesday night of the month after its premier on September 18, 2007. Sign-ups will start at 6:30 pm with poetry readings beginning at 7:00 pm.
